### Sints-Pieter-en-Guido collegiate church

#### **Memorial of Albrecht Ditmar (d. 1439)**

c.1439

sculpted white stone relief, 59 x 94 cm,  
with incised stone inscription, 44 x 56 cm

*Current Location:* Anderlecht, Sints-Pieter-en-Guido church

*Imagery:* A canon kneels before the Virgin and Child, accompanied  
by Sts Guy, Peter, Vincent and Waudru.

#### **Memorial of unknown canon**

c.1480-1510

sculpted white stone relief, c.100 x 75 cm

*Current Location:* Anderlecht, Sints-Pieter-en-Guido church

*Imagery:* A cleric, presented by St John the Baptist, kneels before  
the scene of Christ carrying the Cross.

*Inscription:* lost (repainted in 19<sup>th</sup> century)

*Literature:* Wauters 1851-55, I, p. 66 (although memorial is  
misdated to 1597).
