Imagery: A man with a boy and a woman with a girl are presented by Sts John the Baptist and Giles to the Virgin and Child.

Memorial of Jehan le Salles, Jehanne Macquet (d. 1496) & Jehanne Casée

c.1898, after original of c.1496 or after
white stone sculpted relief, 112 x 90 cm (copy by François Vermeulen after lost original)

Current Location: Binche, Saint-Ursmer collegiate church

Imagery: Sts John the Baptist and John the Evangelist present a kneeling man and woman to the Pietà.

Inscription: Ci gisent Jehan le Sall[es -] ... [-] qui trepassa en lan mil / cccc quatre vingts seize le second jour de juillet aussi demiselle Jehanne / macquet sa premiere feme et demiselle J[-] la seconde [-].
